Conjunction Words

•If Clause

1- If + Simple Present, Simple Present.

- If I eat too much, I get fat.
- If somebody waves a red flag, it usually means danger.

2- If + Simple Present, Simple future.

- If she eats all that ice cream, she will feel terrible.
- She will feel terrible if she eats all that ice cream.

3- If + Simple Present, {S+ would+ V. + Comp}.

- If you don't eat so much, you would lose your weight.
- You'd lose your weight if you don't not eat so much.

4- If + Simple Past, {S+ would+ V. + Comp}.

- If I worked, I would not be poor.
- If he knew the truth, he would get rid of that job immediately.



Conjunction Words

•If Clause

5- If + Past Perfect , {S+ would have + P.P + comp}.

- If they had studied so hard, they would have succeeded.
- They 'd have succeeded if they had studied so hard.
- If I had worked harder, I would have passed the exam.
- If you hadn't driven so fast, you would not have crashed.

6- If + Simple Present, Imperative Statement { V. Comp.}.

- If you are hungry, have much.

7- If + Simple Future, Simple Future.

- If he will not agree, there will be a problem.

8- If + Simple Past, Simple Present.

- If I wanted anything, I always get it.
