Adding -ing Form

1- Normally, Start a statement by the ing form of a verb.

2- We can often use the -ing form of a verb like nouns.

Ex: Browsing a web is popular.

Ex: Some people like shopping online.

3- Often we use -ing form after a prepositions.

Ex: Without leaving home you can visit anyone on the Web.

Ex: By clicking on the link you can move to another page.
