Processing Words

New: Begins a new file containing no data.

Open: Start the application ready for use.


Save: Save the document to disk.

Edit: Alter the data in the document.

Insert: Enter information into the disk.

Print: Send the data to the printer to be printed out.

Format: Alter the appearance of the text.





Active and Passive Voice



- •We use passive voice if we want to focus on the action more than agent.
- •Passive voice usually is used in formal writing such as Research paper or literature English language.

Simple Present:

Voice	Active	Passive
Simple Present	S + V. + object	Object + is/ am /are + P.P. + S
Example	He does the H.W.	The H.W is done by him.

Active and Passive Voice



•Perfect Present:

Voice	Active	Passive
Perfect Present	S + have/ has + pp. + object	Object + have/ has + been + pp. + S.
Example	I have done the H.W.	The H.W has been done by me.
